



Terms of Website Use

This page (together with the documents referred to on it) tells you the terms of use on which you may make use of our website www.webplay.org ("our site"), whether as a guest or a registered user. Please read these terms of use carefully before you start to use the site. By using our site, you indicate that you accept these terms of use and that you agree to abide by them. If you do not agree to these terms of use, please refrain from using our site.

Information About Us

www.webplay.org is a site operated by Webplay (UK) ("We"). We are registered in England and Wales under company number 04992162 and have our registered office at 1st Floor Downstream Building, 1 London Bridge, London SE1 9BG. Our VAT number is 885915763.

We are regulated by the Charities Commission.

Accessing Our Site

Access to our site is permitted on a temporary basis, and we reserve the right to withdraw, suspend or amend the service we provide on our site without notice (see below). We will not be liable if for any reason our site is unavailable at any time or for any period.

From time to time, we may restrict access to some parts of our site, or our entire site, to users who have registered with us.

If you choose, or you are provided with, a user identification code, password or any other piece of information as part of our security procedures, you must treat such information as confidential, and you must not disclose it to any third party. We have the right to disable any user identification code or password, whether chosen by you or allocated by us, at any time, if in our opinion you have failed to comply with any of the provisions of these terms of use.
